CONSISTENT COASTAL WINDS. NORTHEAST TO SOUTHWEST ROW DIRECTION. WINES FROM THIS SECTION TEND TO CARRY A TROPICAL NOTE WITH GOOD ACIDITY.

# **AROMATICS**

There are aromas of banana custard, fennel bulbs, chamomile flowers and buttered toast that lift from the glass.

Oak aging has provided rich crème brûlée, brown spice, and toasty notes.

# **PALATE**

The palate opens with rich textured notes of stone fruit, golden apple pie-a-la mode, papaya, and sweetened cream. Elegant and balanced with balanced with marcona almonds, lavash bread, and a hint of salinity with a long bright finish.
